Are you without a landline? Unfortunately, Chalford has once again been subject to the theft of copper cables. This means that we at the Parish Centre along with many residents, have been affected and are currently without phone lines. Openreach engineers are in the area and are working to reinstate our phone lines, although we don't yet have an estimated date for when this work will be complete. If you contact your provider, they should be able to temporarily divert calls from your landline to a mobile, should you wish to do so. If you need to get in touch with us, please email us, although we are in the process of sourcing a mobile phone.

A419 resurfacing – by the time you are reading this the resurfacing works will be well underway. The eagerly anticipated resurfacing of the A419 started on the 12th September and is estimated to finish on the 17th October. Boots Bussage – You may be aware that Boots recently announced plans to close 300 stores across the UK. In response to this we wrote to the CEO of Boots to express our concerns and to stress how vital the Tanglewood Way Boots is to the community. We are pleased to say that we received a response from Boots, confirming that at the current time there are no plans to close our local branch! This is reassuring news.

Footpath Tasks for the Autumn- The Chalford Parish Footpath Volunteers have some interesting tasks lined up for Autumn. These include joint activities with ChalCAN and Bisley with Lypiatt Parish Council footpath group. With ChalCAN (who have acquired the funding) and France Lynch Church we're installing a bike rack at the Church Rooms. We're working with ChalCAN and Frith Youth Centre to arrange the installation of a bike rack at the Youth Centre. ChalCAN have again acquired the funds, and the Footpath Volunteers are again providing the labour. We're collaborating with our footpath counterparts in Bisley on a major task to improve the so-called death slide on the path down from below The Lamb to Bismore. Replacing and adding steps and a handrail are on the agenda.

Silver Street Car Park – The Parish Council have recently taken on the ownership of this car park from Stroud District Council. We want to engage with residents to understand the views of those who use, or may be affected by the ongoing management of, the car park. The Council will be holding a consultation event on Thursday 19th October at the France Lynch Church Rooms.
