This year we are combining our Annual Meeting of the Parish with VE Day celebrations. This event will be held at Chalford Sports & Social Club, Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> May 2025. Doors open from 6.00pm and the Annual Meeting starts at 6.30pm. This part of the event is open to all and free of charge. ### Footpath work in Blackness and on Rack Hill

Your Footpath Volunteers have been busy recently. In Blackness we've put a safety fence on the path into the nature reserve from Brownshill Road (really a steep track blocked off by bollards) where there's a steep drop down to the track, and we've removed a tree that was blocking the steps down to the track at the end of the Public Right of Way that runs along the side of the Toadsmoor Valley. We're planning to repair the steps and install a handrail in the next few months to make the descent to Brownshill Road easier. On Rack Hill, we're replacing nearly 40m of decaying safety fence above Sunny Bank, for which the materials have been provided by Gloucestershire County Council Public Rights of Way.

### **May Elections**

All voters are required to show an accepted form of photographic identification (photo ID) to be able to vote at a polling station.
