Footpath Volunteers to improve accessibility

Over the last few years your Footpath Volunteers have worked to improve accessibility to



the Parish's playing fields for wheelchair and mobility scooter users. We started by putting stone down where the surface was muddy, and then widened gaps and replaced safety barriers that were difficult to use. Now, after a recent successful trial laying hoggin (fine, buff-coloured self-binding gravel) at a Bussage playing field entrance, we'll be rolling out hoggin at all playing field entrances that need its smooth, firm finish. We'll also put it on the new path into the Frith

Wood car park.
