

The Parish Council is sorry that the residents of Sycamore Grove and the landowners, GreenSquareAccord, are in dispute about the wall along the boundary of the development.

The disagreement is between GreenSquareAccord and the residents who have erected the wall. The land where the wall has been built belongs to GreenSquareAccord and not the Parish Council.

The Parish Council has always wanted a properly constructed wall along the frontage. However, reinstating a wall was not part of the plans that Stroud District Council approved. The Parish Council has no powers to change Stroud District Council's decisions.

The stone the residents took to build their wall was to be used for restoring walls the Parish Council is directly responsible for. This work is carried out by our volunteer team.

We are very happy to work with the residents, GreenSquareAccord and Stroud District Council to achieve an amicable resolution.
