AGENDA ITEM 8 - PLANNING APPLICATIONS TO BE CONSIDERED ON 20th AUGUST 2026

S.26/1283/TCA	Chalford Baptist Church – T1. Western Red Cedar. Crown raise over the road to approximately 5m. T3. Western Red Cedar. Sever Ivy at the base and remove a 300mm band where practicable.
S.26/1285/TCA	Nut Tree House - Walnut tree - reduce all over by 5 metres. Row of Pollarded Sycamore Trees - cut back by 5 metres to previous top.
S.26/1319/TCA	Willows, High Street - Birch trees (1-5) - reduce by 1-1.5 metres. Birch tree (6) - fell.
S.26/1330/TCA	Frome Lodge - Norway Spruce - fell.
S.26/1322/TCA	2 Brookside - Conifer tree - sectional fell.
S.26/1373/TCA	St. Hilary's Cottage - Beech tree - cut to ground level.
S.26/1405/TCA	PROW – MCH44 Chalford - Section 211 Notice. Crown lift all roadside trees to 5 metres, to allow safe access for resurfacing machinery and associated highway works. Remove all self-seeded trees establishing on or immediately adjacent to the highway surface, to prevent obstruction, maintain visibility, and protect surfacing integrity.
S.26/1314/HHOLD	Yew Tree Cottage – Erection of two storey and single storey extensions, dormer windows and associated landscaping.
