Cllr Pearson left the meeting at 9.40am

S.26/0020/TPO The Limes, Stony Riding - T1 Lime – fell. T2-T6 Lime – Pollard by 6m. Cllr Humberstone proposed “we support this plan”. This was seconded by Cllr Taylor and all in favour.

Cllr Pearson returned to the meeting at 9.50am

Cllr Morris-Wyatt left the meeting at 9.50am – Cllr Pearson in the chair.

S.26/0040/TCA Rockleigh, Rack Hill – T1 – pear – fell. T2 pear – fell. T3 ash – fell. T4 – pear – crown reduce 3 metres in height and 2 metres in lateral spread. T5 ash – fell. T6 beech – fell. T7 ash – fell. T8 ash to fell. T9 ash – fell. Cllr Humberstone proposed “we support this plan”. This was seconded by Cllr Pearson and all in favour.

Cllr Morris-Wyatt returned to the meeting at 9.55am

S.26/0066/TCA Woodview, Dark Lane – T1 – T3 – ash. T4 sycamore – re pollard the trees to the old points of the last pollard. Cllr Humberstone proposed “we support this plan.” This was seconded by Cllr. Pearson and all in favour.

S.26/0104/TCA Vine House, Silver Street – Trees 8,9,10 and 11. Cypress – remove. Tree 7 dessert apple – remove. Cllr Pearson proposed “we support this plan”. This was seconded by Cllr Humberstone with one abstention.

S.26/0115/TCA Holly Bank, Commercial Road – T1 yew – reduce and shape. Reduce the height by approx. 4m, reduce laterals by approx. 3m to shape the crown accordingly. T2 yew – reduce and shape. Reduce the height by approx. 2.5m, reducing the laterals back to the boundary, approx. 3m. Cllr Pearson proposed “we support this plan”. This was seconded by Cllr Humberstone and all in favour.
