

GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH MCH59 AND MCH60
(CHALFORD PARISH) STROUD DISTRICT ORDER 2019

WHEREAS the Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") being the Traffic Authority for Public Footpaths MCH59 and MCH60 as defined in the Schedule below ("the Footpaths") is satisfied that use of the Footpaths should be temporarily prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near them.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its power under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, hereby makes the following Order:

CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 18th November Two Thousand and Nineteen and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding six months commencing from the date when the footpath was closed initially by notice on 28th October 2019 and may be cited as "Gloucestershire County Council Temporary Closure of Public Footpath MCH59 And MCH60 (Chalford Parish) Stroud District Order 2019"

GENERAL

2. Except for pedestrian access to properties, no person shall proceed on foot nor cause or permit any person to proceed along the Footpath.
3. The Footpath falls in Chalford Parish in the Stroud District in the County of Gloucestershire

SCHEDULE

1. Public Footpath MCH 59 from its junction with MCH 58 extending in a generally easterly direction for a distance of approximately 205 metres to its junction with the High Street.
2. Public Footpath MCH60 from its junction with MCH 59 extending in a generally north easterly direction for a distance of approximately 85 metres to its junction with the MCH 56.
